

# 2023 NH Scholastic Team Chess Championships

## Eligibility

Open to teams of 4 K-12 students (plus alternates if desired) who live or go to school in NH. A team's players must be from the same school district (though perhaps at different schools therein). Exceptions for players active in clubs outside their district may be requested. The grade level of a team's most-advanced student determines the team's section. Team rosters should list players from strongest to weakest and consistently play with that order throughout the event.

Players must be members of the NH Chess Association and the U.S. Chess Federation. 1-year junior NHCA memberships cost \$6, but a \$40 club membership affords a scholastic club's players NHCA membership for 11 months. USCF memberships are \$20 for those who will be under the age of 19 at the time of expiration and \$27 for those who will be under the age of 24 at the time of expiration. Memberships may be purchased online at uschess.org (preferred) or at tournament registration. Current members should bring membership cards or receipts with them.

*Players are to provide their own equipment. They should bring a chess set, board and clock (if possible) and a pencil or pen to record moves. A limited number of extra sets will be available for those who do not have equipment.*

**Entry Fee:** \$10.00 per player if received by 7 pm on April 14th. \$15.00 per player if paid at the tournament.

### High School

*Grades 10-12*

Game/60 min, each player  
4 Games, No Eliminations

### Jr. High School

*Grades 7-9*

Game/45 min, each player  
4 Games, No Eliminations

### Elementary

*Grades K-6*

Game/30 min, each player  
4 Games, No Eliminations

Teams who provide their information by the advance entry deadline will still get the advance entry price even if they pay their fees at the door.
